



EDFAS Lifetime Achievement Award

DEFINITION

EDFAS Lifetime Achievement Award was established by the EDFAS Board of Directors in 2015 to recognize leaders in the EDFAS community who have devoted their time, knowledge and abilities towards the advancement of the electronic device failure analysis industry.

RULES

- A. EDFAS membership is mandatory.
- B. Candidates for the award may be proposed by any EDFAS member in good standing.
- C. Nominations must be submitted to EDFAS headquarters no later than March 1 of the year in which the award is to be presented.
- D. Nominations are eligible for three years.
- E. EDFAS Lifetime Achievement Awardees, upon recommendation of the EDFAS Nominations and Awards Committee, will be approved by the EDFAS Board of Directors at its spring meeting.
- F. The frequency of the award will be at the discretion of the EDFAS Board of Directors.
- G. The award will be presented at the International Symposium for Testing and Failure Analysis.
- H. Recipients of an EDFAS Lifetime Achievement Award will not be required to pay EDFAS membership dues.
- I. Candidate may be selected for this award posthumously.

DESCRIPTION OF AWARD

The award shall consist of an inscribed plaque.

AWARD SELECTION COMMITTEE

- A. The selection committee shall be the EDFAS Nominations and Awards Committee.
- B. The Committee shall consist of no more than five (5) members.
- C. The Committee shall review, evaluate and recommend a recipient to the EDFAS Board of Directors for final approval.
