



EDFAS PRESIDENT'S AWARD

DEFINITION

The EDFAS President's Award shall recognize exceptional service to the EDFAS and the electronic device failure analysis community. Examples of such service includes, but are not limited to, committee service, service on the Board of Directors, organization of conferences or symposia, development of education courses, student and general public outreach. While any member of EDFAS is expected to further the Society's goals through service, this Award shall recognize those who provided an exceptional amount of effort in their service to the Society. The recipient is selected by the EDFAS President.

ELIGIBILITY

Nominees shall be members of the Electronic Device Failure Analysis Society and must have provided service to the society for at least 10 years.

DESCRIPTION OF AWARD

- A. The Award shall be a plaque indicating the name of the recipient, the name of the Award, and a citation.
- B. The Award shall be presented at the International Symposium for Testing and Failure Analysis.

NOMINATION AND SELECTION

- A. Any EDFAS member in good standing can nominate a candidate by providing the necessary background to the chair of the EDFAS Nominations and Awards Committee or directly to the EDFAS President. The necessary background consists of a detailed listing of all EDFAS related activities of the candidate, the impact of these activities, and why these activities are considered extraordinary.
- B. Nominations are due March 1 of the year in which the award is to be presented.
- C. The chair of the Nominations and Awards Committee will forward all nominations received to the EDFAS President. The President will select the recipient of the award. There shall be no more than one recipient selected per year.
- D. Candidate may be selected for this award posthumously.
