

EDFAS VOLUNTEERING EXCELLENCE AWARD

DEFINITION

The EDFAS Volunteering Excellence Award honors members of EDFAS who exemplify the highest ideals of volunteer service. The vitality and success of EDFAS depends on its members, and their willingness to contribute their time and talents for the good of the society and the electronic device failure analysis community.

The purpose of this award is to recognize those whose selfless commitment, positive attitude, and enthusiastic service embody the true spirit of volunteerism. These individuals consistently go above and beyond, making a meaningful and lasting impact through their contributions to EDFAS initiatives, local chapters, and committees.

ELIGIBILITY

Nominees shall be members of the Electronic Device Failure Analysis Society.

DESCRIPTION OF AWARD

A. The Award shall be a plaque indicating the name of the recipient, the name of the Award, and a citation.

B. The Award shall be presented at the International Symposium for Testing and Failure Analysis.

NOMINATION AND SELECTION

A. Candidates for the award may be proposed by local EDFAS chapters, EDFAS committees, or any three members of EDFAS in good standing.

B. Nominations are eligible for three years.

C. Recommendations must be submitted to EDFAS Nominations and Awards Committee not later than March 1 of the same year in which the award is to be presented.

D. Statements of at least three EDFAS members familiar with the candidate's endeavors should be included with the nomination form.

E. Up to two awards may be presented each year.

F. Suggested citation of not more than thirty words should appear on the nomination form.
